## BRANCH 2 & 3 STRUCTURAL PEST CONTROL BUSINESS 2025 REGISTRATION NOTICE

This letter is to inform you that the registration allowing your Structural Pest Control Business to conduct operations in Orange County will expire on December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024. **You must register with the county Agricultural Commissioner prior to performing structural pest control activities in the 2025 calendar year. It is unlawful to perform pest control work in Orange County without first registering with the Orange County Agricultural Commissioner.**

1. Fill out the enclosed registration form, listing all Satellite or Branch Locations and Qualifying Manager and Branch Supervisors. Please provide an email address.
2. Mail or walk-in your completed form and \$10 registration payment to the Orange County Agricultural Commissioner's Office (**222 E. Bristol Ln., Orange, CA 92865**). Do not mail cash.
3. The registration fee is \$10.00 per PR number.

## Notice of Regulatory and Sulfuryl Fluoride Labeling Changes

10/1/2024

Recent California Code of Regulation and Sulfuryl Fluoride labeling changes may impact the operations of structural pest control businesses performing work in California.

### New Standard Structural Fumigation Log—Title 16 California Code of Regulation (CCR) Section 1970(a).

Effective October 1, 2024, the text of the regulation and the Standard Structural Fumigation Log (Form number 43M-47) have been amended. This amendment incorporates a new Standard Structural Fumigation Log by reference and removes the text describing the components for the fumigation log fields from the regulation. The form was redesigned to clarify several fields and enhance the readability of each section. **Effective October 1, 2024, the revised Standard Structural Fumigation Log is required to be implemented into pest control operations.**

### Sulfuryl Fluoride labeling update

On July 30, 2024, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency announced approval of the new Vikane and Zythor gas fumigant product labels. The revised product labels from Douglas Products and Ensystem now contain additional protective measures and requirements.

Existing stock of fumigant under the previous labels will continue to be sold. However, once fumigant under the new labeling is received and used by your company, you will be responsible for adhering to the revised labeling and for having available the new label and manual at use sites. Please contact your Sulfuryl Fluoride representative for additional details.

### Proposed Changes to the Occupants Fumigation Notice and Pesticide Disclosure (OFN)—Title 16 CCR Section 1970.4

Proposed changes to 16 CCR §1970.4 would require the use of a revised OFN form (Form number 43M-48). The revised form is meant to be clearer and easier for both industry and consumers to understand and comply with.

This regulatory change is currently under review with the Office of Administrative Law. If approved, the regulation change may become effective as early as January 1, 2025.

## Notice of Recent and Upcoming Regulatory Changes

10/1/2024

Recent California Legislative Bills and California Code of Regulation may impact the operations of pest control businesses performing work in California.

### Rodenticide Law Update—Food and Agricultural Code (FAC) Sections 12978.7 and 12997.8

Assembly Bill No. 2552

Effective January 1, 2025, FAC 12978.7 is amended to limit most uses of pesticide products containing **chlorophacinone** and **warfarin**. FAC 12978.7 already limits most uses of **diphacinone** and second-generation anticoagulant rodenticides (**brodifacoum**, **bromadiolone**, **difenacoum**, and **difethialone**).

Prohibited uses include residential or home uses and most industrial and institutional uses. For example, prohibited uses include, use in and around restaurants (that do not have an attached brewery or winery), grocery stores, airports, offices, construction sites, transport vehicles (e.g. ships, trains, aircraft), ports and terminal buildings, shipyards, timber yards, schools, shopping malls, sewers, and sewage treatment plants. Many non-production agricultural uses are also prohibited (such as use around man-made structures at cemeteries, golf courses, and parks).

In addition, this assembly bill adds code section FAC 12997.8, which places users liable for a civil penalty up to **\$25,000** per day for each violation for unlawful use of products containing any of these active ingredients.

### Neonicotinoids for Non-agricultural Use Law Update—FAC Section 12838

Assembly Bill No. 363

Beginning January 1, 2025, a person shall not sell, possess, or use a pesticide containing one or more neonicotinoid pesticides for any use on nonproduction outdoor ornamental plants, trees, or turf; with the exception of use and possession by state certified applicators and sale by state licensed pest control dealers.

“Neonicotinoid pesticide” means a pesticide containing **acetamiprid**, **clothianidin**, **dinotefuran**, **imidacloprid**, **thiamethoxam**, or any other chemical designated by the department as belonging to the neonicotinoid class of chemicals.

## Handler Training Regulation Update—Title 3 California Code of Regulations (CCR) Section 6724

Effective January 1, 2024, the Pesticide Handler Training Program has been updated with new requirements, which includes training on how to identify when a product is a federal or California restricted material and documentation of training on safe operation of pesticide use equipment.

Training is to be held in a location reasonably free from distraction and the trainer must be present for the entire training and respond to employee questions. Training records are required to include the trainer's name, source material, and, for employees handling restricted materials, include the trainer's qualifications.

New training form templates, which are compliant with the updated recordkeeping requirements, are available on the California Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) website (search for enforcement letter "ENF 23-20"). ## Restricted Material Handling Recordkeeping Regulations Update—Title 3 CCR Section 6624.5 and Title 16 CCR Section 1970(b)

Effective January 1, 2024, in non-structural settings, and October 1, 2024, in structural settings, the name and license number of the certified commercial applicator who applied or supervised the application of a restricted material is required to be documented with each pesticide application record of a restricted material.
